


"Teachable Moments"

OBJECTIVE: In this lesson we will introduce a simple way for learning how to seek truths from God's Word by continuing the biblical narrative and using a slightly different format in the instruction and activities.

- Simple Truths: The basic truths are in each of the four boxes, but you will notice some development of these truths in the bold-print questions. These will give you information to discuss with your children and might also stimulate more questions to explore.
- Activity Pages: Remember to use these as learning opportunities, so enjoy them together. Follow instructions on each page.
 - #1 TRUTH SEEKER STUDY
 - #2 STORY TIME: Sinfulness Continues (You may read as written or read directly from the Genesis portion, depending on the age of your children.)
 - #2 "Evil" Word Search
 - #3 Family Lines (Family Trees)
- **Enjoy singing &** learning together: No new song in this lesson.
- Memorize: Genesis 6:5
- **Prayer Time:** Your prayer time with your children can certainly be a special part of your study time. It will give them opportunity to think carefully about what they want to say to God as they begin their Bible Study time.

Simple Truths

How can I study?

- --Use a simple, but consistent plan to help you discover truths from God's Word.
- --There is a suggested plan on Activity Page #1 to help your child learn how to study the Bible.

Why should I study God's Word?

--God's Big Story will help us learn important TRUTHS about. . .

GOD'S Character? SINFUL MAN? GOD'S BIG PLAN? Living GOD'S WAY?

2 Many people filled the earth.

Did Adam & Eve obey God's command to have a family?

- --Yes, they did, and their children had children and so on, generation after generation.
- --Eventhough Cain killed Abel, God gave Adam and Eve another son--Seth--to carry on the **Family Line** of God's own choosing.

Were the generations of all families recorded for us in the Bible?

- --The family lines, often called *Family Trees* were recorded only of the families God wanted us to know about.
- --The Head of the Family from Adam to Noah are listed on Activity Page #3.

Answers for Activity page #3. (930, 912, 815, 910, 895, 962, 365, 969, 777, 950)

--It is interesting to notice how long each of the fathers lived, from Adam to Noah. Wow! They had children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, great, greatgrandchildren and probably more; we don't know for sure because God did not tell us and that's o.k.



Sin became worse and worse on the earth.

--We will learn the answer to this question in the story of our next lesson. Don't miss it.




There are four things we need to do when we study the BIBLE. In each Truth Seeker Lesson you will be doing these four things.

- #1 PRAY: Ask GOD to help you understand what He wants you to know.
- #2 READ: There is a story in each lesson; also find it in your Bible.
- #3 ASK QUESTIONS:
 WHO is the character(s)?
 WHAT is the story?
 WHERE does it take place?
 WHEN does it take place?
 HOW does it happen?
 WHY . . . is there a purpose?

#4 MEDITATE (THINK): Item #3 will give you information to think about to help you better understand GOD'S purpose for each story in the BIBLE.

Sinfulness Continues on the Earth

(Based on Genesis 5:1 - 6:6)

In the beginning we learned that Adam and Eve had two boys--Cain and Abel. Remember, Cain's heart was controlled by sin and he killed his brother in anger. God gave Adam and Eve another son, named Seth. Cain had children too: they did not want to follow God, but the children of Seth wanted to depend on God. Many more people filled the earth, but most of the people were controlled by their sinful hearts. More people means more sin on the earth. People of all ages were unkind to one another. Does sin please God? Of course not. In our next lesson, we will learn about God's solution to this problem.


