- 1."EROS" or romantic love
- 2." AGAPE" general affection & commitment
- 3. "PHILEO" or brotherly love. This is the love we want to look at this month.

Once we become a Believer, we are now a part of the **FAMILY** of God and now we have a whole plethora of siblings! Scripture instructs us to "LOVE THE BRETHREN". "As you live God-like, be kind to Christian brothers and sisters and love them." (2 Peter 1:7 CEV)

The key to our loving other Believers with brotherly love is to train ourselves to think properly about the other members of the family of God. God calls us to view each Believer as one "for whom Christ died". In Christ, God has laid down His life for the Brethren. We, too, are to lay down our lives for one another. Jesus has patiently born with us. We, too, are to bear with one another. Jesus has died to forgive us of our sins. We, too, are to forgive one another. Jesus continues to build us up in the truth. We, too, are to build one another up in the truth. Jesus ever lives to make intercession for us. We, too, are to intercede for one another. To neglect, or forsake, assembling with other believers is to turn from God's design for His church and embrace a false substitute: the notion that Christianity is individualistic, rather than familial or communal. At their very core, church gatherings are not events held so that we can consume spiritual content. Church gatherings are *an essential* means of grace whereby Believers worship and are equipped to live as God's witness people in the world."
