

## "Teachable Moments"

OBJECTIVE: This lesson will focus on the second week of ADVENT with the lighting of the second candle (purple) and scripture and songs about JESUS' coming to earth, born in the humble village of Bethlehem; revealing GOD'S heart.

- Simple Truths: Notice that the four truths for this lesson deal with GOD'S love expressed in the INCARNATION by each member of the GOD-Head. Truth No. 4 is a great time to focus on the personal response to this love with each of your children.
- Activity Pages: The Parent pages (Simple Truths, Suggested Advent Activities) will help you navigate these learning times, but the actual activity pages for your children contain alot of information as well. Remember, this is just a beginning; in your reading of God's Word you will no doubt find additional info to include future years. Don't in forget to continue the advent wreath colorina from lesson, and add another the previous page (LOVE) and more purple chain to the wall-art.

## Simple Truths

### The FATHER'S Love Revealed to us

### How did GOD (the FATHER) show us His Love?

- --He **PROMISED** a Savior (MESSIAH) to His people <u>through many prophets</u>.(See the last lesson for more details.)
- --The FATHER SENT His Son (as prophesied)

"This is love: not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as an atoning sacrifice for our-sins." (I John 4:10)

# --The FATHER **revealed His PURPOSE** for the INCARNATION before the event actually happened.

"... what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. She **will** give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name JESUS, because <u>He **will save** His people from their sins.</u>" (Matt. 1:20-21)

#### How did God prepare for His Plan?

--GOD chose the exact time in history.

"But <u>when the time had fully come</u>, God sent His Son, born of a woman, born under law, to redeem those under law, that we might receive the full rights of sons." (Gal.4:4)

--GOD chose the place of Christ's birth: Bethlehem

"But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, though you are small among the clans of Judah, <u>out of you will come for me one who will be ruler</u> <u>over Israel</u>, whose origins are from of old, from ancient times." (Micah 5:2)

--GOD chose a special person to give birth to JESUS: Mary.

". . .Do not be afraid, Mary, you have found favor with God. You will give birth to a son, and you are to give Him the name Jesus."" (Luke 1:30-31)

--GOD chose a special person to care for Mary and baby JESUS: Joseph

"...an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, 'Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife... When he woke up, he did what the angel of the Lord commanded him..." (Matt. 1:20 & 24)

--GOD chose a special person to help prepare for the ministry of the Messiah.

"And you, my child, will be called a prophet of the Most High; for you will go on before the Lord to prepare the way for him, to give his people the knowledge of salvation . . . ." (John 1:76 & 77).

The SON'S Obedience: He Came

### Why is His coming so important?

--He demonstrates obedience to His Father by coming into the world He made.

"He came to that which was his own . . ." (John 1:11)

--He demonstrates obedience to His Father by obeying and completing God's purpose .

*"Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet <u>not my will,</u> <u>but yours be done</u>." <i>(Luke 22:42)* 

The HOLY SPIRIT: Provides God's Love

--In JESUS' birth.


Our Response to His Love

## Suggested Activities for the ADVENT Celebration



The ADVENT WREATH is a circular garland of evergreens representing **eternity**. On that wreath are 4 or 5 candles typically arranged. Each represents an aspect of the spiritual preparation for the coming of the LORD, Jesus Christ. One candle is lit on each Sunday of advent, and the 5th candle on Christmas Eve.

With each week of ADVENT, you and your family can focus on the celebration elements mentioned here. Be as creative as you wish by adding other carols to sing, additional scriptures appropriate to the event represented by each candle, or invite another family to share with you in the celebration. The following lessons will focus on the subsequent candles and together you can prepare your hearts and minds to enjoy the true "Reason for the Season." May GOD be glorified!



As TRUTH SEEKERS, this season of the year gives us a chance to explore the heart of GOD and see His plan for His creation revealed in a very special way.



GOD loves us so much and wants us to be a part of His family. He wants our hearts to be filled with thoughts about Him and love for Him.







JOSEPH'S Respnse to Angel's announcement

MARY'S Response to Angel's announcement


